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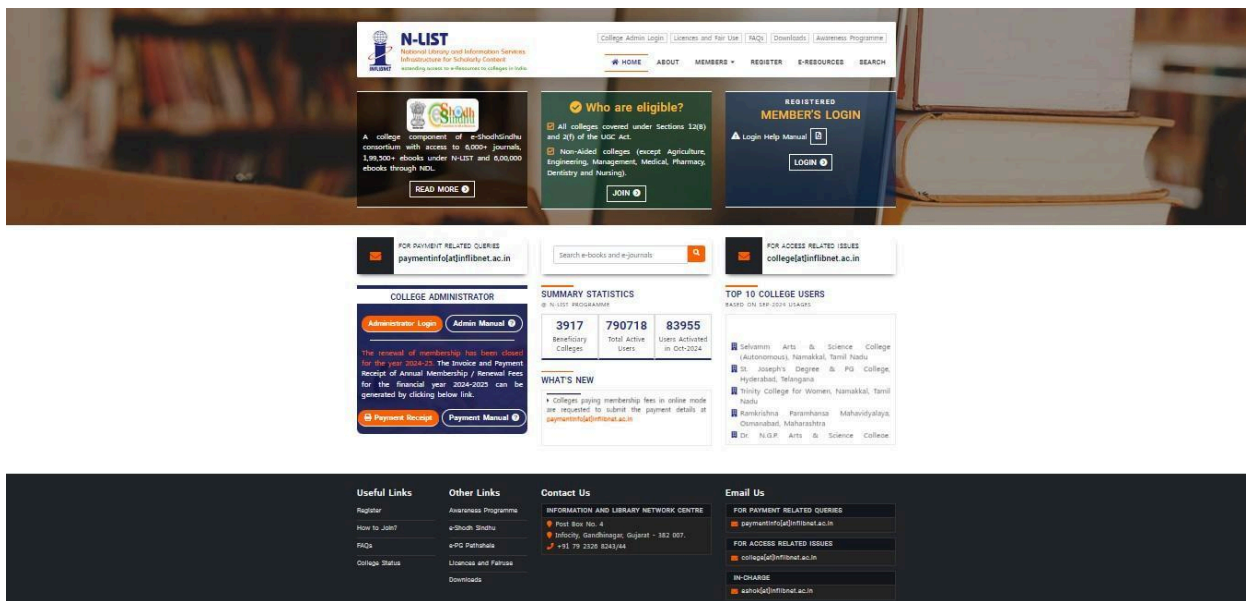
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USE OF ICT TOOLS INCLUDING ONLINE RESOURCES

1) N-LIST

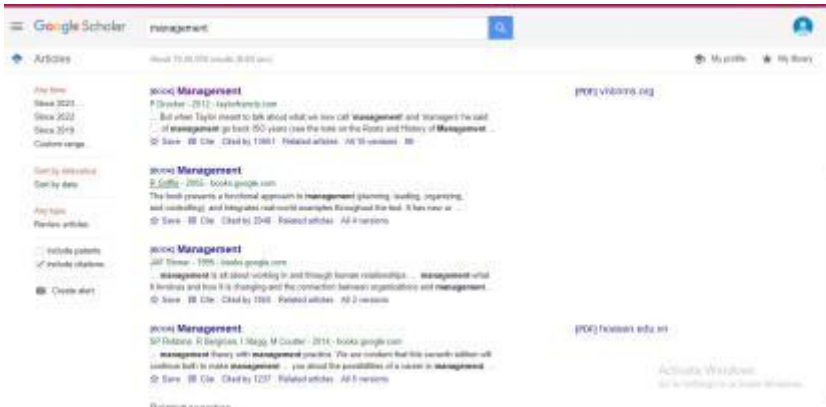
