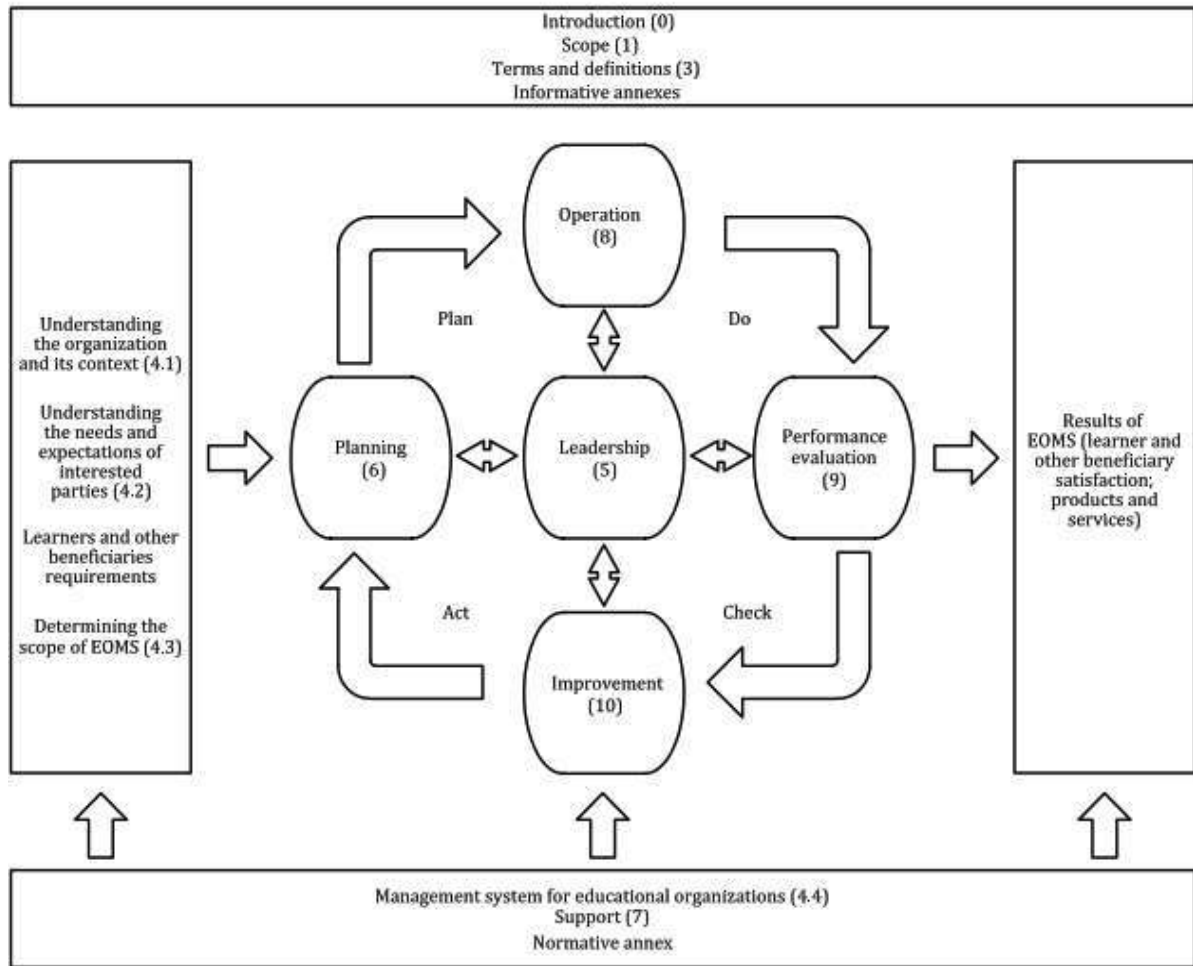




Figure 2 — Representation of the structure of this document in the PDCA cycle
