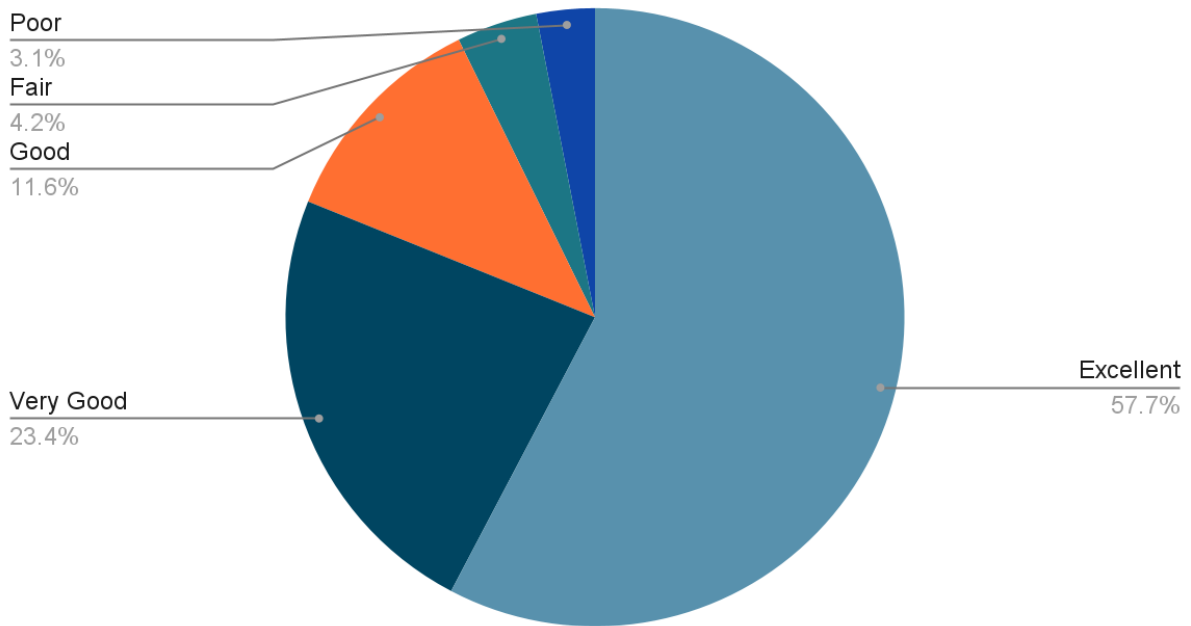

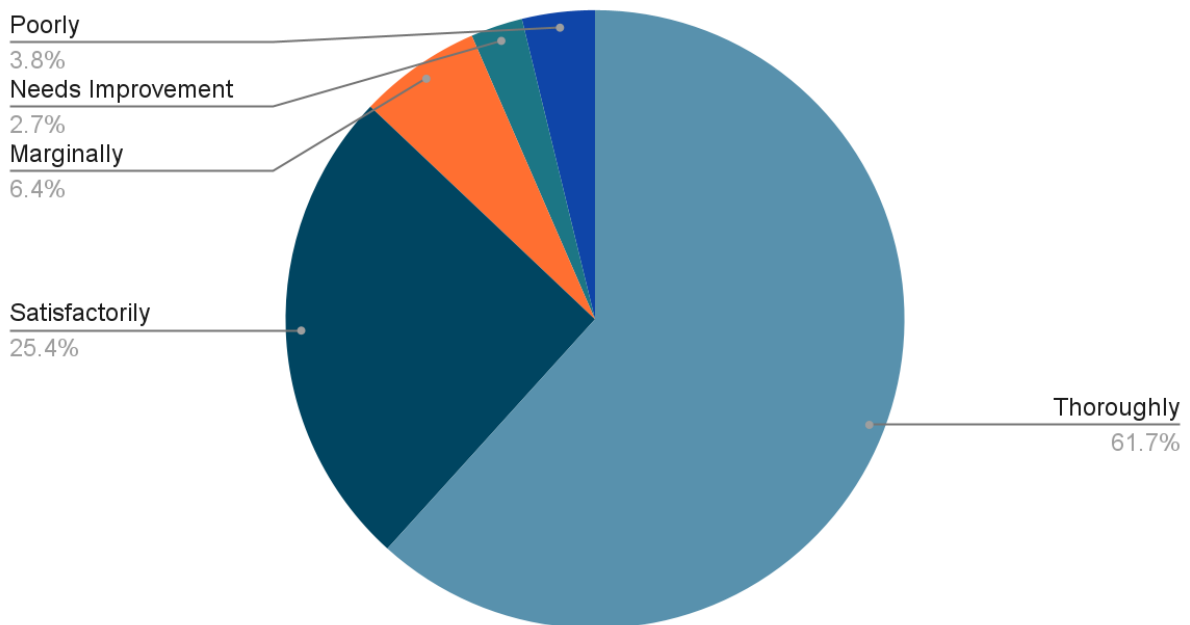

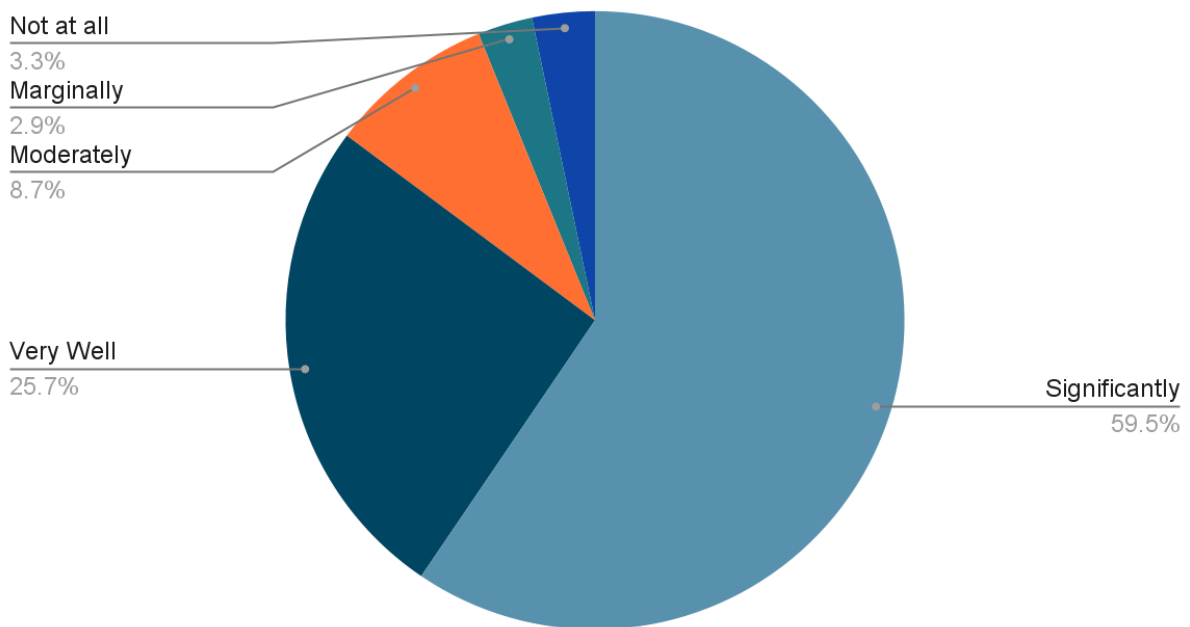

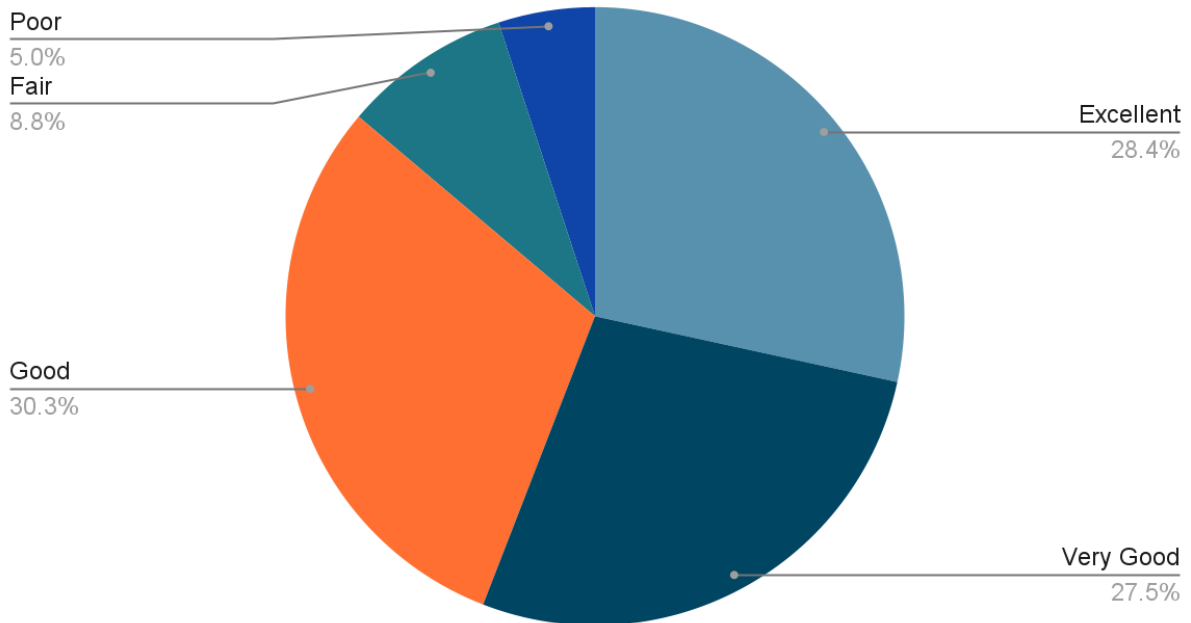

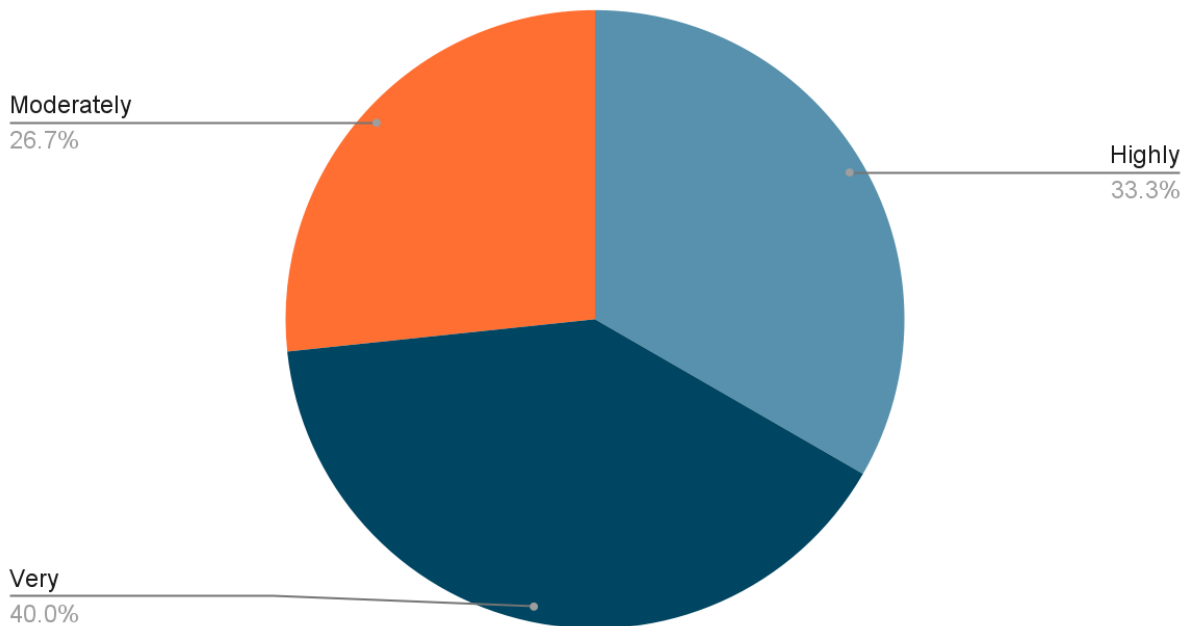

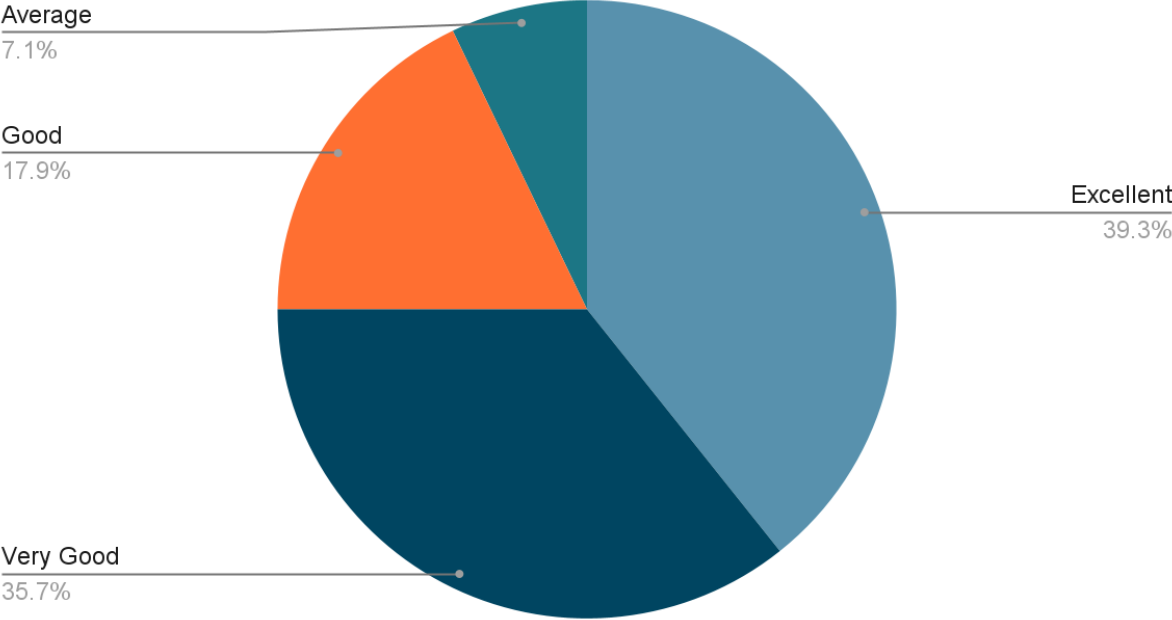

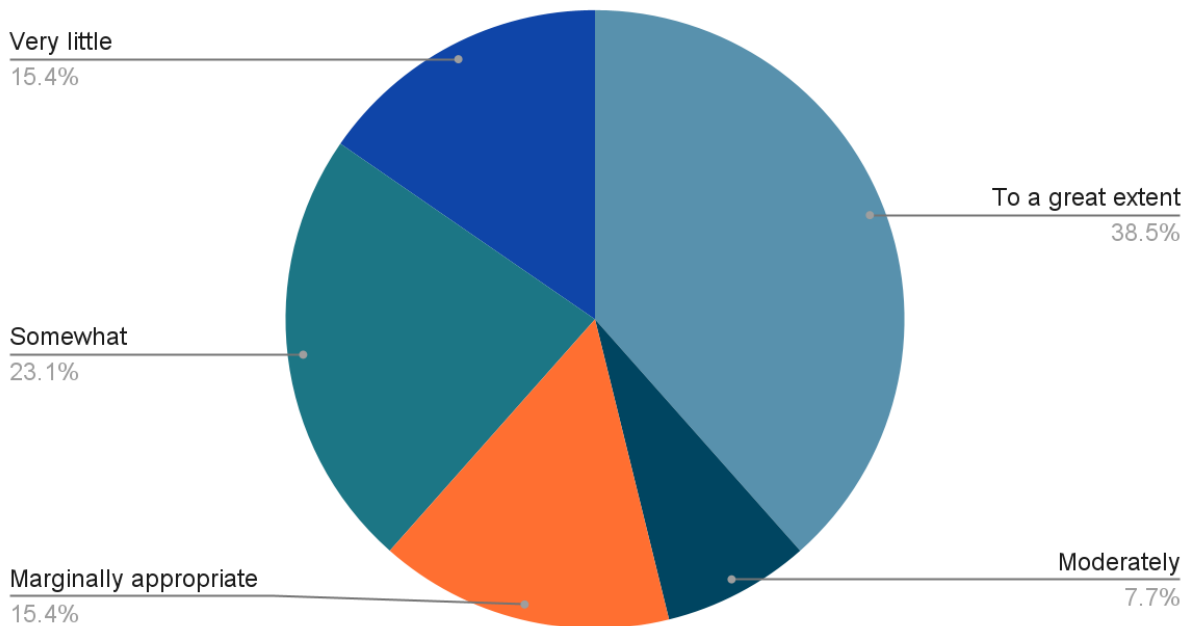

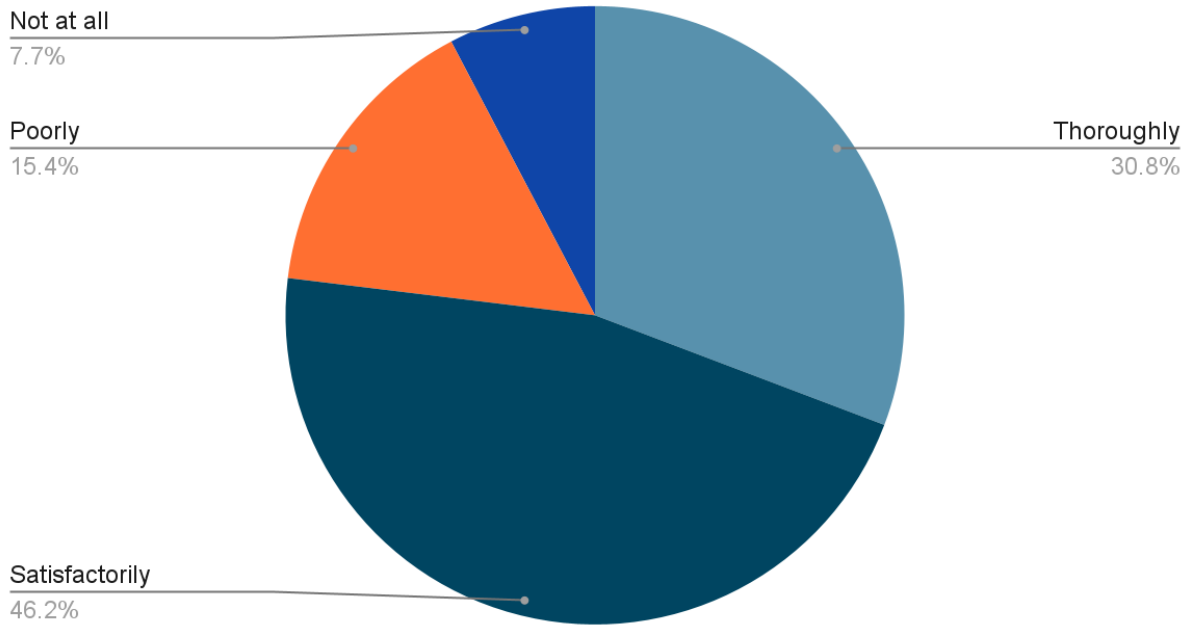

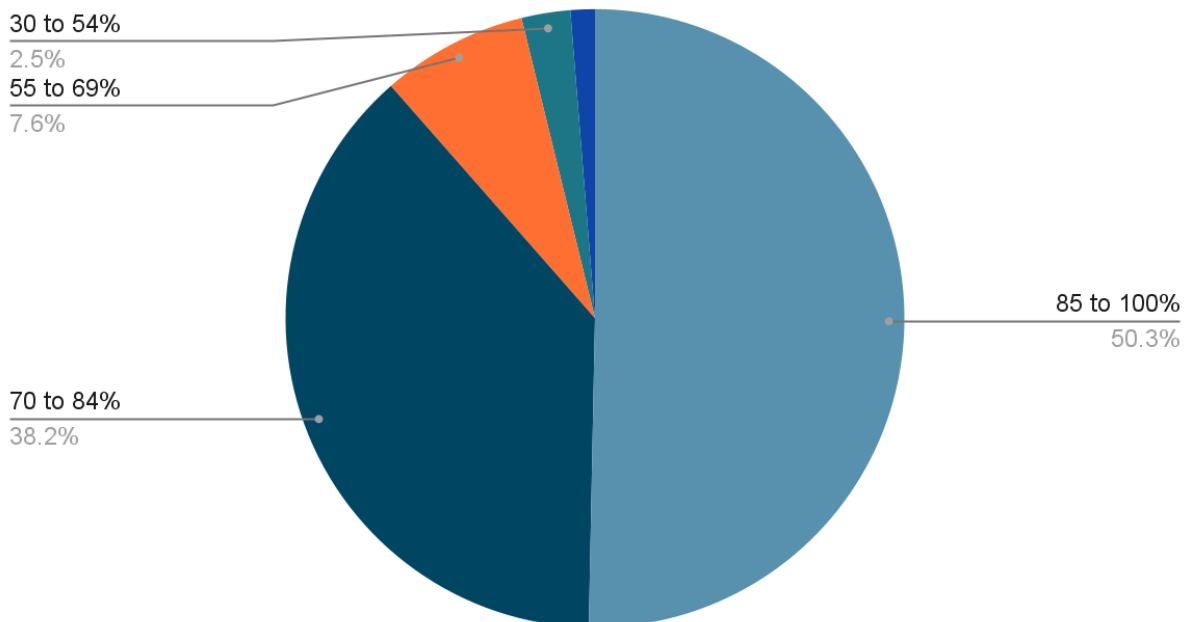

Report on Feedback for A.Y. 2022-23


The College has sought feedback from various stakeholders using two types of questionnaires as suggested by NAAC as under:
