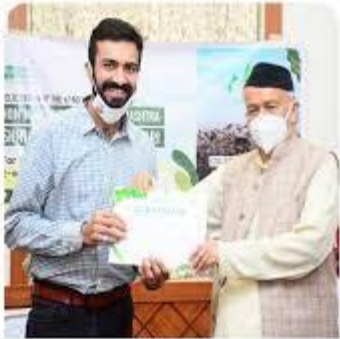
Mumbai University will do its bit towards achieving the country's target of carbon neutral status by 2070 by carrying out a green audit of all its 800-plus affiliated colleges with the help of National Service Society (NSS) units. The university will not only help colleges calculate their carbon footprint, but also offer solutions and implement them in reducing it. Principals have welcomed the move, but making the project sustainable will be challenging, they add. In the first phase, with the help of NSS units and an in-house start-up, GoShoonya

F The project will give students first-hand experience in sustainable solutions, making them industry ready, said Gopal Raithatha, an NSS student from GoShoonya—a campus start-up at Thakur Ramnarayan College of Arts and Commerce. "The audits will be done by students, but we will also have external auditors from specialised domains to help them. Once the audit is done, we will give colleges affordable solutions to reduce their carbon footprint. For colleges which are unable to afford alterations, we will help in arranging corporate social responsibility funding or donors," said Raithatha. Waste management, alternative sources of energy like solar, water management, rainwater harvesting, developing city forests are some methods by which colleges can contribute to the project.
